In the first part of this presentation, Gemma will present preliminary results of a cross-Canada study of the state of experiential and clinical learning in common law jurisdictions across Canada. In the second part of the presentation, Adam will present findings from his research report on one promising form of experiential education in Canada, social justice externship programming.
